

JOB DESCRIPTION

Position: Youth Facilitator - Human Trafficking Peer Prevention Project
Type: Contract One Year (Part-Time)
Reports to: Project Manager

Aura Freedom is seeking Presentation Facilitators who identify as female and are between the ages of 18-25 to deliver anti-human trafficking presentations to youth in schools, shelters and group homes in the City of Toronto, and appropriately refer and support survivors who come forward as a result of these presentations. The project is divided into two 6-month phases and are described below.

Phase 1 (6 months):

- Attend and participate in training workshops on various topics including human trafficking, anti-oppression, gender inequality, trauma informed training, consent, and presentation skills (all training is paid).
- Shadow seasoned Aura Freedom facilitators during anti-human trafficking presentations for additional training and in order to deliver feedback to Aura Freedom on how to improve existing presentations from a youth point of view.
- Complete various administrative tasks in order to achieve project goals.

Phase 2 (6 months):

- Develop an anti-human trafficking presentation to deliver to schools, youth shelters, and other community youth spaces in order to create awareness of and prevent human trafficking (for the purpose of sexual exploitation) based on training and shadowing.
- Communicate with Presentation Coordinator on bookings and other organizational matters.
- Deliver human trafficking awareness presentations in various locations throughout Toronto.
- Provide survivors identified through the presentations with referrals to appropriate services.
- Collect data from presentation participants through a survey.
- Assist in the creation of a final project report identifying project outcomes using the data collected (testimonials from survivors, qualitative and quantitative data and case studies).
- Complete various administrative tasks in order to achieve project goals.

Recommended Skills/Traits:

- Has a bold outlook and courageous heart that makes human rights and equality a priority
- Strong demonstration of commitment, self-motivation and passion for making a difference in the lives of youth in the City of Toronto
- Motivated to further public education on important topics including the prevalence of human trafficking and other forms of violence against women and girls and passionate about the education of these important topics to relevant populations
- Ability to initiate and maintain positive and supportive relationships with others
- Effective interpersonal and communication skills
- Proficient in Microsoft Office and comfortable using various social media

In addition to the extensive training curriculum the youth facilitators will complete and the mentoring/coaching provided by Aura Freedom, we believe that life experience will aid these facilitators in excelling at this position. Candidates of particular interest are those that have lived experience with abuse/violence, oppression, bullying, homelessness, human trafficking and/or addiction.
